Caring Cities Campaign: LULAC is one of the many nonprofit groups that Mayor Gluba has asked for support from. We have met on numerous occasions with the campaign changing focus over time from establishing a local processing center to housing 100 – 200 unaccompanied minors, opening up area homes as temporary shelters for the children, and providing legal services for these children. LULAC has stated that we are not resourced to provide immigration or refugee services. However we will support the initiative by our participation.

Nahant Marsh Education Center: LULAC Youth Council 600 visited Nahant Marsh Education Center late last month. The Nahant Marsh is a 265-acre preserve nestled in southwest Davenport. It is part of a 513-acre wetland complex that is bordered by the Mississippi River, Interstate 280, and Highway 22. In addition to the youth group members their younger siblings were also invited. Marsh staff provided the group with a tour of the marsh looking at the vegetation and wild life at the Marsh. Additionally the group attended a presentation at the education center that included discussion on reptiles which the children enjoyed. After the visit the children had lunch there. 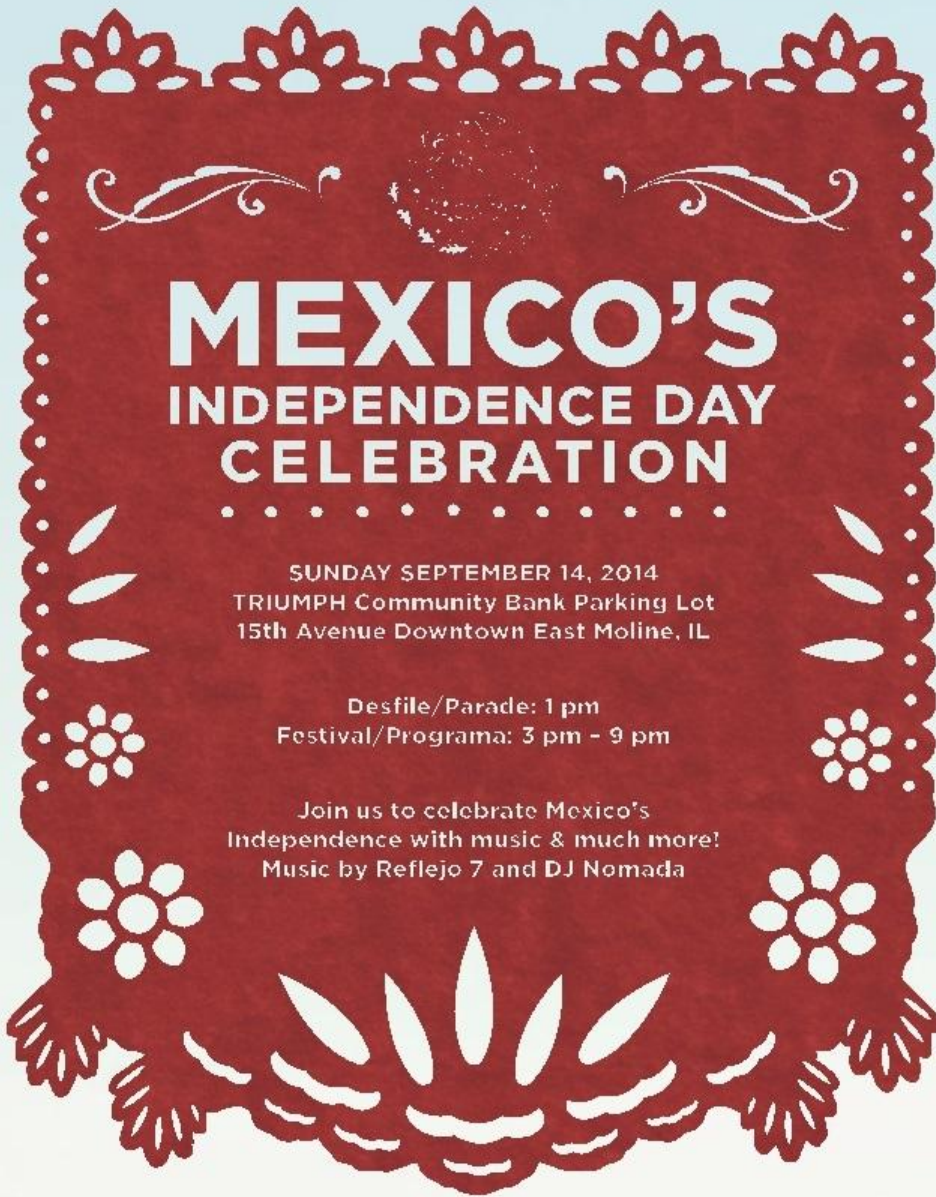
