General application instructions entering Freshmen must include:

- Fill out the scholarship application in its entirety, Sign and Date.
- Include your acceptance letter and/or registration from a college or university you plan to attend*
- High school transcript with cumulative GPA
- Include a typed or neatly printed not more than 300-word essay on <u>personnel and career goals</u> and <u>community service</u>

General application instructions Upper Classmen:

- Fill out the scholarship application in its entirety, Sign and Date.
- Include a current and most recent transcript from the college or university you are attending*
- Include a 300-word essay on personnel and career goals and community service

We are also awarding Honor Awards Scholarships from \$1,000.00 - \$2,000.00. The instructions are the same as above, however, the criteria are as follows:

- The student has a GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale or equivalent, and, if the student is an entering freshman,
- The student scores 23 or higher on the ACT test, or 1100 or higher on the SAT test.
- For consideration of an Honors award, entering freshman <u>must</u> submit a copy of their ACT or SAT score report.
- All Entering Freshman students <u>must</u> submit a copy of their high school or college transcripts with GPA.
