
BECOME A DEFENDER OF POTENTIAL

Community-Based

- 1-to-1 mentoring program
- Matches a Little (child ages 8-14) with a Big (adult volunteer)
- 12-month commitment
- Meets 2-4 times a month, often evenings or weekends
- Do activities of interest to both—car shows, fishing, outdoor activities, home improvement projects, watching movies, attending a concert or sporting events
- Attend free BBBS facilitated activities

School-Based Plus

- 1-to-1 mentoring program
- Matches a Little (child ages 5-11) with a Big (adult volunteer)
- 12- month commitment
- Meets 2-4 times a month during lunch and recess at the Little's school
- Play board games, read books, talk, or go out for recess
- Able to meet with your match outside of school (not required) such as BBBS facilitated activities or something of interest to you both
